

# Frocks & Frolics

## Spring Basket



Cut

1x Base

1x Lining Base

1x Base Strengthening (cutting board or similar)

2x Bag

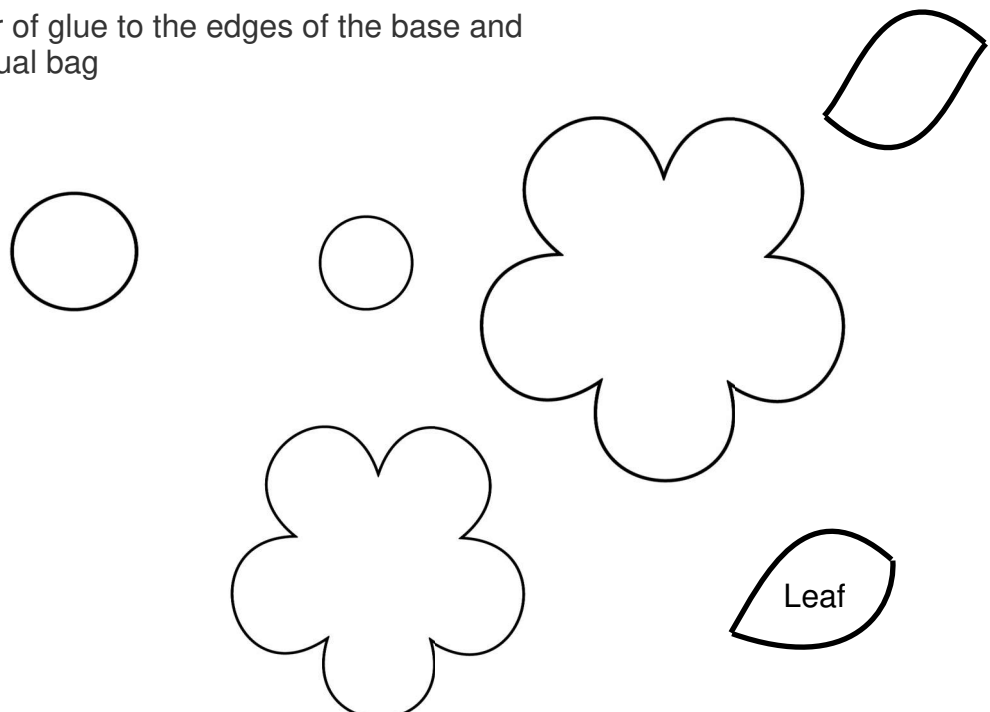
2x Bag Facing

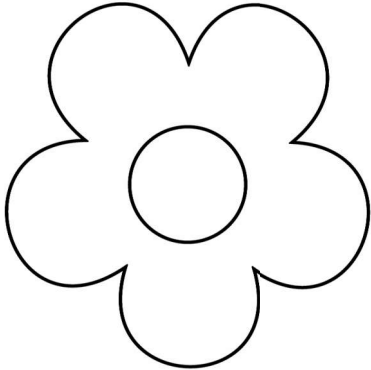
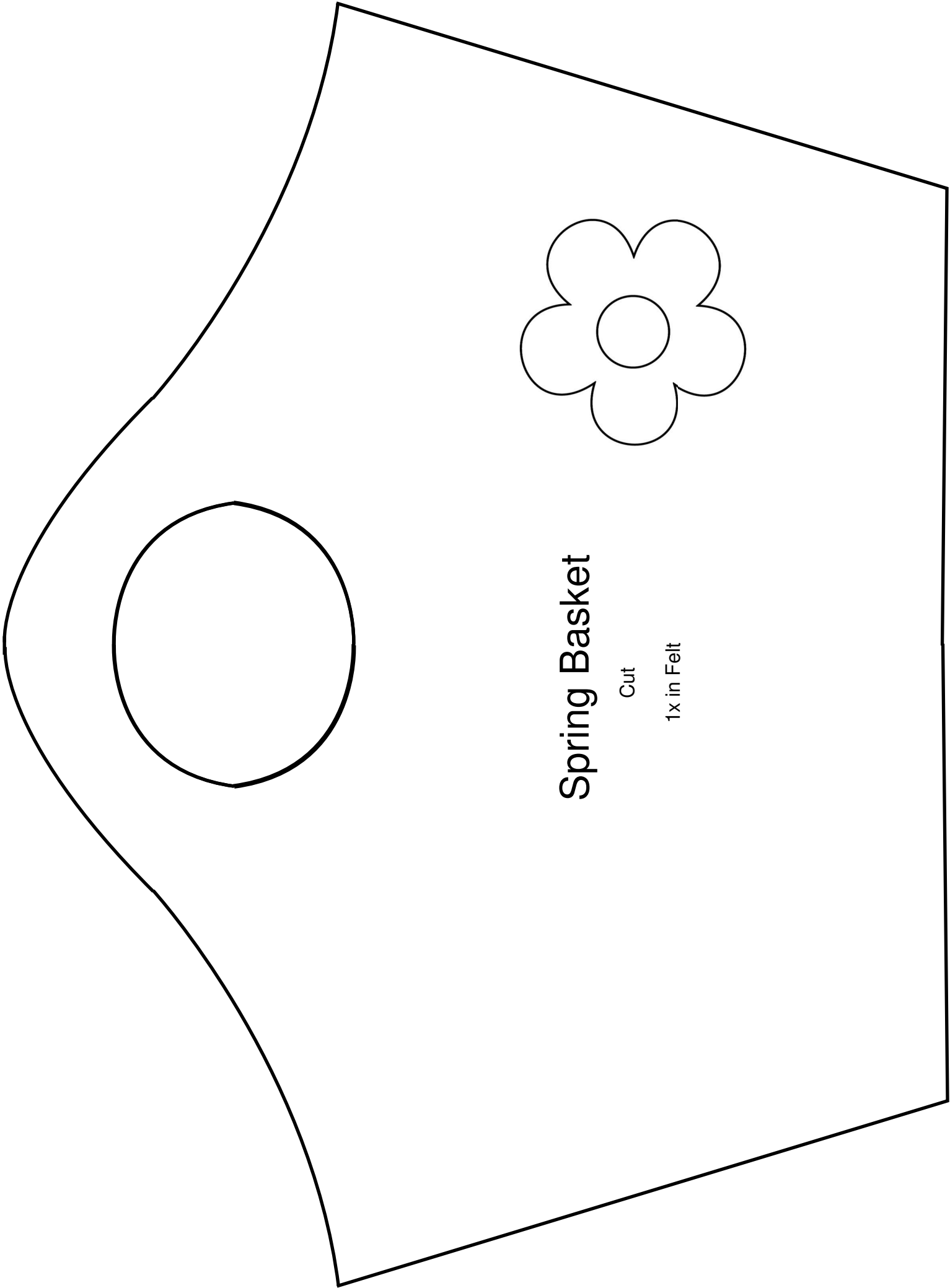
3x Flower

3x Center of Flower

As many Leafs as you like!

1. Position your flowers and stitch on to the front of the bag
2. Add center of the flower
3. Stitch the stem in triple stitch
4. Add the leafs
5. Cut the handle out of the pattern. Place the pattern on top and draw inside the handle with a pencil
6. Sew the sides of the bag together using a zig zag stitch, positioning the pieces flat next to each other
7. Sew together the facings in the same way (it's not necessary to add a facing if you have very sturdy felt)
8. Place the facings to the inside of the bag and stitch all the way around the top using a pretty embroidery stitch
9. Sew around the handle on the pencil line, firmly joining the facing and the outside of the bag
10. Cut away the handle circle 5mm inside the stitching line
11. Sew the base to the bottom of the bag, right sides facing
12. Put glue on to the strengthening and place on top of the second base
13. Add another layer of glue to the edges of the base and press into the actual bag

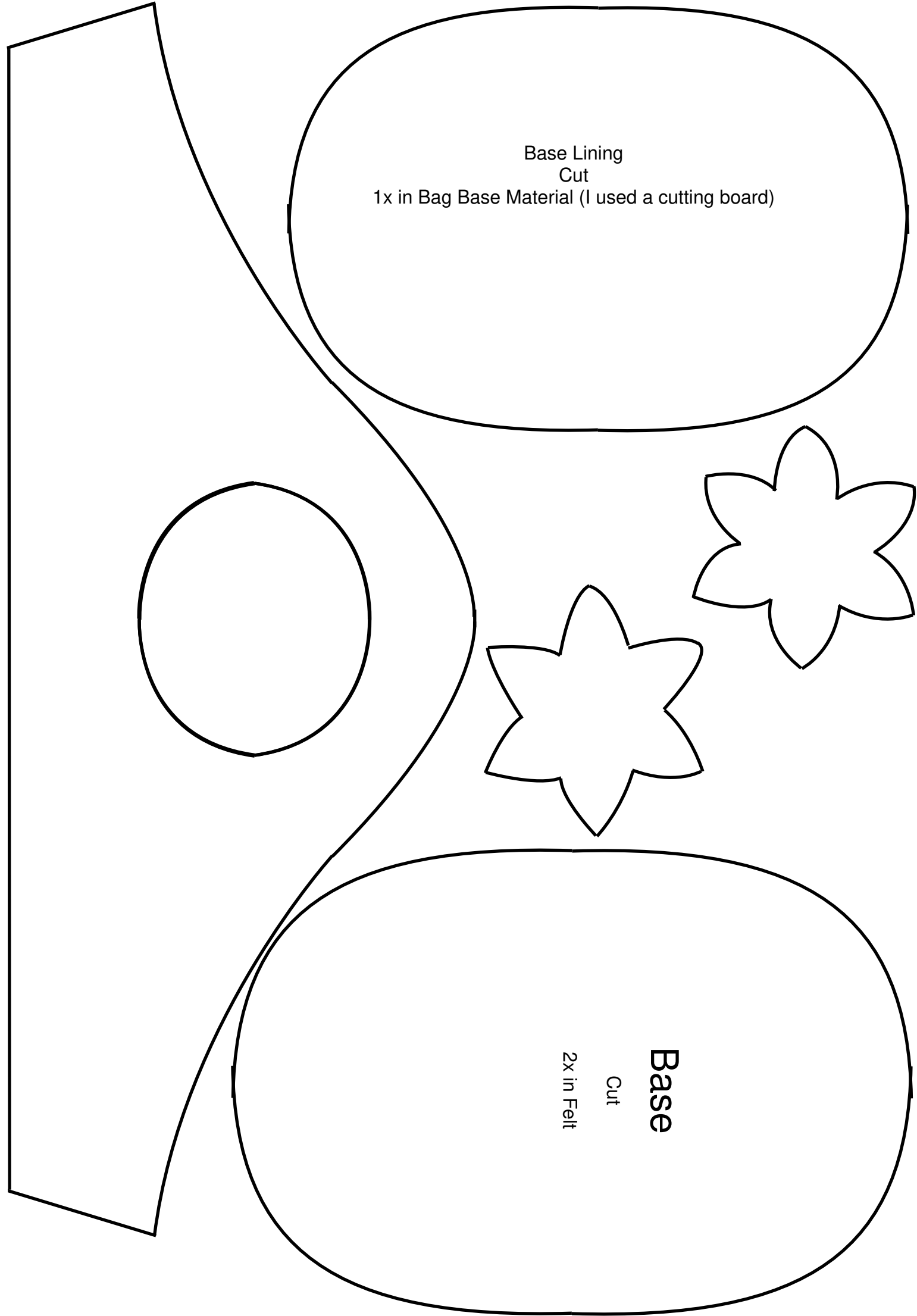
